### *Live the Flexi-catered or Self-catered life*

The Village at Burgmann is comprised of six buildings of self-catered apartments situated in a leafy and relaxed environment.

The 'Street' running through the centre of the Village is a place to meet friends or hold social events.

There are four types of accommodation options: 5 Bedroom Apartments, 3 Bedroom Apartments, 2 Bedroom Apartments and Studios.



### **Flexi-catered**

All Village accommodation is self-catered. However, Village residents can choose Flexi-Catered living in the Village. This gives residents the flexibility to select the meals that fit within their schedules when they do not feel like cooking. All meals are served in the dining hall. Residents can enjoy this flexibility while still enjoying the community that develops within the fully catered resident buildings.



### **Self-catered**

Village residents may prefer the fully self-catered lifestyle. Resident fees for the self-catered option still include one weekly dinner in the dining room, and periodically when a special theme dinner is arranged. Other package options are available; casual meals are also available for \$12 per meal.

### **Village formal dinners**

Villagers come together two times a year for a formal dinner in the Dining Hall where they celebrate community, good food and each other's company. This is included in both the self-catered and flexi-catered rates.

### What's a 5 bedroom apartment like?

Each **5 Bedroom Apartment** has a shared kitchen with cupboards for storage space, four hot plates, fridge and an oven. There are two showers and two toilets. Each resident in the apartment has a private lockable room containing a standard king-single bed and a study desk. Groups of five residents each have their own separate rooms, but share a living room and kitchen so can make meals together.

### Can I preference who I live with?

The College endeavours to allocate rooms with a spread of resident interests and backgrounds. Generally in multi-share apartments, undergraduate residents live with other undergraduate residents; this can be across year levels and is a helpful way to residents to learn about how the community works. In multi-share apartments, postgraduate residents generally live with other postgraduate residents. Residents are welcome to request who they would like to live with if known, however, part of living in a community is getting to know people you otherwise would not.



### Length of Contract

The Village contract is 47 weeks and commences on **Monday 23 January 2023**. However, some flexibility in start dates can occasionally be accommodated. The Village contract end date is **Monday 18 December 2023**

### What's Pastoral Care like in the Village?

We are proud to have a high ratio of Residential Advisors to residents, at 1:16 in our Village. We have dedicated undergraduate and postgraduate Residential Advisors in the Village. Our Deputy Principal, College Dean and two of our Residential Fellows also call the Village home. We invest in pastoral care and ensure this level of support because we know it is important.

### New Neighbouring Student Accommodation

Residents are welcome to request who they would like to live with and room allocations can be confirmed before residents sign their contracts. For example, five residents who would like to live in a five-share apartment can apply and be considered together.
